

Food and Environment Protection Act 1985: Part III Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986

Schedule - Conditions of Approval – Great Britain

The following are the conditions under which approval has been granted. Any changes from those detailed in this Schedule (and certificate issued) may invalidate the approval and be in contravention of the Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986 (as amended).

Dilute 1 part of product with 10 parts of water then apply 1 litre of diluted product per 10 square metres of surface

3.4. Advertisement

The advertisement requirements in

- Article 72 of Regulation (EC) No. 528/2012, as it has effect in Great Britain (GB BPR) (as from time to time amended); and
- Articles 25 (4) and 48 of Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 of the 16th December 2008, as it has effect in Great Britain (GB Classification, Labelling and Packaging of substances and mixtures Regulation)

apply in addition to the requirements of the Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986 (as amended).

4. Additional conditional of Approval

Approval Holders are required to submit immediately any new information on the potentially dangerous effects of a product or residues of an active substance contained in a product, on human or animal health, ground water or the environment.

5. Data requirements

Explanatory notes:

4. The product label and packaging should reflect the conditions of Approval for that specific product e.g., the relevant product trade name, suffix, Marketing Company contact details and pack size.

Any approved uses that are not relevant to the Approval Holder's/Marketing Company's current marketing strategy do not need to appear on the product label. However, for those uses which are included on the label, all the conditions of Approval relating to those uses must be included.

5. The power to amend or revoke the approval is exercisable at any time by HSE.
